Limited WIC services include the following:

Benefit pick up (eWIC card re-loading) appointments:

- These will be quick appointments to minimize time spent in the WIC Clinic.
- Bring you ID and eWIC card.
- Do not bring children or other family members to these appointments. Only the endorser or proxy needs to come to the WIC Clinic for eWIC card re-loading.

If you need your food package adjusted or have a formula change – you must contact the WIC office and speak to WIC staff. Leave a message if no one answers your call. Please do not walk into the WIC office to tell us you have a formula change, or you need a food package change. WIC staff will contact you to make the changes over the phone and give you a date and time to come into the WIC office.

If you are in need of breastfeeding support or have questions related to nutrition education – please call 570-322-7656 or 570-748-1087. Make sure you leave a message if no one answers the phone.

If you are a new participant and have completed an on-line application—you will be contacted by a WIC Nutritionist to receive further instructions.
